- Top grain leather with strong fibers resistant to tears comparing with splits or fabrics. It breathes naturally and regulates temperature when it absorbs and releases humidity through natural pores which cannot be found in splits or artificial leather.
- Appearance: Matt.
- Thickness: 0.9-1.1mm.
- Corrected meaning that the leather has been sanded (or buffed) to reduce the visibility of natural markings of raw hides.
- Pigmented (dyed) with protected color-finishing on leather surfaces that serves to waterproof and ensures color consistency as well as high durability. It will just slightly fade under long sunlight exposure and is very well protected against normal household stains.
- Embossed with Madras Print creates uniform appearance and greater texture on the leather surface. Embossing is a process that re-creates the leather surface pattern and makes it smoother as well as softer by dry milling. Our embossing process preserves the natural elegance and the feel of premium leather.

This top grain leather is corrected, pigmented and embossed with "Dollar Americano" print. The leather has been buffed to reduce the visibility of natural markings on the raw hides. It has been pigmented (dyed) with protected color finishing that serves to waterproof and ensures color consistency as well as high durability. This leather is very well protected against normal household spills and is easy to clean with light detergent and water. Orvieto is the most popularly used leather category for high-end contemporary sofas.



Pigmented (dyed) with protected color-finishing on leather surfaces that serves to waterproof and ensures color consistency as well as high durability. It will just slightly fade under long sunlight exposure and is very well protected against normal household stains.

Embossed large-grain prints create uniform appearance and greater texture on the leather surface. Embossing is a process that re-creates the leather surface pattern and makes it smoother as well as softer by dry milling. Our embossing process preserves the natural elegance and the feel of premium leather.

SPESSO can create the appearance of a finished sofa comparable to that of being made by ultra-thick materials such as TORO (around 3mm), with the prices significantly lower than those in TORO (Category F1). SPESSO can be applicable to almost all KELVIN GIORMANI models.

Top grain leather with strong fibers resistant to tears comparing with splits or fabrics. It breathes naturally and regulates temperature when it absorbs and releases humidity through natural pores which cannot be found in splits or artificial leather.

Natural grain aniline leather with matching color at the base of the hides and is finished with waxes and aniline. It's kneaded by hand with a special treatment that livens up the surface and gives it a peculiar velvet touch. The hand-made vintage effect gives this article its main character.

With such a vivid vintage pattern, this article is particularly good to go with sofas with minimalistic designs or with less irregular shapes-and-forms.



- Appearance: Semi Glossy with a Silky Hand; Thickness: 1.3 to 1.5 mm

This top grain leather is full grain meaning that the leather is not corrected or buffed, preserving most of the natural characteristics of the hide. This leather is for connoisseurs as only the best hides can be used to produce this type of leather. The user must also appreciate the natural characteristics of the leather, including some of its natural markings. This leather is colored with a transparent dye containing aniline (as a result, color variation within a hide can happen). Aniline leather has a very limited amount of chemicals applied which makes it the softest and finest upholstery leather. With very little protective coating, Marco can easily be scratched by fingernails and colors will fade in direct sunlight. No embossing allows the natural grain and variations of the leather to be seen and preserves its natural softness. This type of leather literally lives with the owner and increases in softness with usage and time.

- Appearance: Matte; Thickness: 2.8 to 3.2 mm

This leather is similar to Orvieto in its technical characteristics as it a corrected grain leather, as well as pigmented and embossed. What makes this leather unique is its thickness–2.8 to 3.2 mm. This thickness emphasizes the volume of the sofa and requires special machinery and skills in its preparation and application in production. Only certain models can be made in this leather.



- Full Grain, Aniline, No Embossing
- Appearance: Matte; Thickness: 1.4 to 1.6 mm

This leather is similar to Marco in its technical characteristics as it is a full grain, aniline leather with no embossing. Unlike Marco this leather has NO protective coating on its surface, making it even more delicate. This leather can be easily scratched by fingernails and colors will fade in direct sunlight.





- Made in Germany with primarily European raw hides
- Full Grain, Aniline, Light Embossing
- Appearance: Matte; Thickness: 1.4 to 1.6 mm

This leather is similar to Marco in its technical characteristics as it is a full grain, aniline leather. Unlike Marco this leather has a light embossing and NO protective coating on its surface, making it even more delicate. The light embossing has been applied for the sole purpose of enhancing the genuine leather appearance and distinguishing it from other non-genuine leather suede materials. This leather can be easily scratched by fingernails and colors will fade in direct sunlight. Sofa users are advised to use a professional "Nubuck Care Kit" as Nubuck is one of the most delicate types of leather.

Appearance: MattThickness: 1.2-1.4mm

Top grain leather with strong fibers resistant to tears comparing with splits or fabrics. It breathes naturally and regulates temperature when it absorbs and releases humidity through natural pores which cannot be found in splits or artificial leather.

Half grain meaning that the leather has been slightly corrected (or buffed), which preserves many natural characteristics of a piece of hide, and whoever will buy the sofas must appreciate the natural characteristics of the leather, including some of its natural markings.

Aniline based leather which is colored with a transparent dye containing aniline (as a result, color variation within a hide can happen). Aniline is a colorless liquid that helps to open pores of the leather. Aniline leather has very limited amount of chemicals being applied which makes it the softest and finest upholstery leather. Without containing any protective coating on surfaces, GEKO can be very easily scratched by finger nails and color will fade in direct sunlight.

No embossing has been applied and the grain seen on the leather surface comes naturally and with variation within a hide. Without embossing, by just applying a simple milling process, the natural softness of the leather can be better preserved.

Waxy. A special wax has been applied to GEKO to create an unusual and natural hand touch of the leather. The application of wax also makes the appearance of the leather more smooth and even but still preserve the aniline transparent & natural look on the hide. Thanks to this special process, very light natural aniline color, such as light beige, can be possible on the leather, and at the same time, the leather won't look as flat and "covered" as of pigmented leather.

Vintage Look. Due to the wax application, the surface of GEKO will appear to change lighter in color when certain pressure is applied onto the leather surface (eg. by fingers). This lighter color "marks" will be even (faded) out after several normal rubbing on the spot; or they can be 80% to 90% removed with the help of "Scratch Away" by Leather Master. On the other hand, after certain years of use, the accumulation of those "lighter" marks will create a kind of natural vintage look (instead of looking old and worn-out) to enhance the personalty of the leather goods.

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Embossed with 3 different kinds of exotic prints, namely MIKONOS (resembling elephant's skin), SANTORINI (resembling bison's skin) and TOTEM (abstract patterns inspired by fashion leathers).
